They feature 1-4 panels per page, contain about 300-600 words in short sentences and include repetition and many of the sight words early readers have to learn.

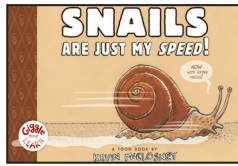
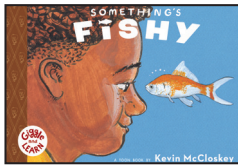
CHAPTER-BOOK COMICS FOR ADVANCED READERS
